Using Modern Techniques and skills Hurricane was designed by a team of 30 Mechanical Engineering Students within a short span of 6 months.

Hurricane with Top speed 50kmph can easily climb hills, steps and moves in ups and downs. 305cc 10Hp petrol engine, coupled with CVT having pneumatic suspension, this Vehicle has the imported spares as a spciallity. Having specifications like 60" wheel base, 62" track width, ride height 12", weight 240kg hurricane is also capable of pulling weights.

This efforts were carried out by a young bunch of budding engineers under the guidance of HOD Dr. Krishna Prabhu along with Asst. Professors Mr. Naveen Kalal & Mr. Prashanth M.V.
