## Institutional Report - 2022-23 (odd semester)

#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF 30th GOVERNING COUNCIL MEETING:

33rd Governing Council Meeting of Canara Engineering College (CEC) was held on 06-11-2023 at 11.00 a.m in the Board Room of Canara Engineering College, Bejnapadavu.

#### Points discussed:

- **33.1.** Sri. D Vasudeva Kamath, President, Canara High School Association (C.H.S.A), presided over the meeting and Dr. Nagesh H R Principal Secretary welcomed all.
- **33.2.** Correspondent Sri. M. Ranganath Bhat introduced new members of GC and informed GC that Dr. Nagesh H R has been appointed as the new principal of CEC w.e.f 16<sup>th</sup> October 2023. He thanked the outgoing principal Dr, Ganesh V Bhat for is contribution to the growth of the institution during his tenure as principal for 10 years. He also informed that Dr. Ganesh V Bhat will continue to serve as Professor in the department of ECE.
- **33.3.** Principal Secretary briefed on the significant achievements of the institution during the year odd semester of AY 22-23 amidst various challenges and demanding situations CEC faced. He then briefed on the agenda of the meeting by giving details of various aspects of the institution up to odd semester of 2023-24.

#### 33.4. Accreditation details:

To start with Dr. Nagesh H R informed members that CEC has been accredited by NAAC with 'A' Grade and a CGPA of 3.24, missing A+ by just 0.01 points. All members congratulated all those who are involved in the work for their effort in getting the institution to this level.

#### 33.5. Admission details:

Our efforts in giving better publicity about the institution via visits to PU colleges and conducting exclusive programs at PU colleges, and also the trend towards IT related branches helped us to get better admission this year also.

Total admissions during 2023-24 is 598 as against the total intake of 662 including SNQ. Admissions to III semester via lateral entry is still pending. Currently, there are 1808 students (292 seats More than previous year) studying in this institution from all branches and years.

#### 33.6 Academic Performance:

CEC has been performing on top when it comes to the matter of academic performance. Dedicated efforts of faculties and staff members well aided by infrastructure have ensured a good result to the college successively. During 2022-23 all exams were conducted under normal mode. It is observed that the average result of all semesters is 90.04% as against

#### 33.7 Student club achievements:

At CEC eleven students' clubs conduct various events related to their core theme. During 22-23, a total of 73 activities by involving more than 60% of the students were conducted. The entire event was managed by students.

#### 33.8 Staff achievement:

During the academic year 2022-23, Karnataka State Council of Science and Technology (KSCST) has funded 5 final year student projects with a total worth of Rs. 22,000/-, 44 four FDPs/Workshops were conducted, 37 papers were published in journals indexed in Scopus/WoS and GS, 11 books/book chapters were published by faculty.

#### 33.9 New branch proposal:

It is proposed to apply for a new branch related to Cyber security or Robotics and Automation during academic year 2024-25.

#### 33.10 Focus on IIC activities:

During the academic year 22-23 we have improved from 1-star rating to 2-star rating in our innovation index of IIC. During 2023 -24 we are planning to secure 3.5 to 4 stars in our innovation rating. Hence, our efforts are concentrated more towards the innovation activities.

#### 33.11 Alumni focus (Global alumni meet):

We are all working towards the second Global Alumni meet scheduled on 24th of December 2023. We will try to get more alumni to the meet and make it successful.

#### 33.12. DST lab and continuation of Grants:



#### 33.13 Faculty and Staff status:

During 2022-23 academic year 22 faculty and 15 staff have joined the institution to make their career at CEC and 15 faculties have left the institution for better prospects.

#### 33.14 Sports and cultural:

Our students have achieved lots of accolades in sports during 2022-23. Top most performance is from Girls Kabaddi team who won the VTU level tournament and 2 of the girls qualified for the University team.





#### 33.15 Plan for 2023-24 even semester:
